ELIGIBILITY:

• Open to all Segerstrom High School students, grades 9-12

RULES:

- To enter the contest, each entrant must write an original poem that reflects on the prompt:

- Entries must: be:
 - Typed using Times New Roman or Arial and 12-size font
 - o Titled
 - 25 lines of poetry or less
- <u>Do not</u> write your name on the poem document. Include <u>only</u> your student ID and grade level.
- Only one poem can be entered into the contest.
- Poems with vulgar, offensive, or profane language will be disqualified.
- All poems will be submitted to Turnitin.com, a plagiarism prevention website. It is essential that each
 entry must be your own original work and cannot contain previously published and/or copyrighted
 material. If the judging panel discovers at any time that an entry contained previously published and/or
 copyrighted material, your poem will be immediately disqualified.
